HEARING OFFICER(S)

<u>Function</u>: Responsible for conducting disciplinary hearings upon the conclusion of the investigation, determining whether the Respondent violated policy, and if so, assigning the appropriate sanction. Hearings must follow strict federal requirements. The Title IX Coordinator may "preside" over the hearings for procedural purposes only. All Hearing Officers will hear each case unlesserve is a conflict of interest or unavoidable scheduling conflict.

ADVISORS

<u>Function</u>: May accompany any party to a meeting or interview during the intake, assessment, and/or investigation processes. May offer guidance on the process to the party but may not participate at these steps. Must accompany a party to a hearing anelxanoisse the other party or witnesses. Avisors may be any person of the party's choosing (eg., family member, friend), an attorney or a Eastern faculty/staff member who volunteers to serve in a pool. Eastern advisors must be able/willing to help any party who selects them from the pool and may not be biased.
