

Academic Warning:

A student is placed on Academic Warning for the semester after the student's cumulative GPA or semester GPA falls below a 2.0. The student will be notified in writing by the Learner Support Services Department and the student is recommended to review his/her status with his/her academic advisor. The student is limited to no more than 12-15 credit hours. Students whose cumulative GPA is below a 2.0, particularly due to transfer credit or academic history from the past, but who achieve or maintain a semester GPA of 2.0 will remain on "academic warning" until their cumulative GPA is above 2.0, but will not

be subject to academic probation unless a semester GPA falls below the 2.0 requirement.

..... why they should be released from those terms and conditions. Academic Suspension will be notated on all official college transcripts.

Regulation Exceptions

This rule does not supersede Standards of Academic Progress for Federal

..... admission programs; (i.e. Nursing) or requirements resulting from articulation or 2+2 agreements with other colleges or institutions.
